BEFORE COMPLETING YOUR ENTRY FORM, PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING:

1. Vehicles built after 1994 may be entered but are not eligible to be judged.
2. The close-off date for lodgement of Entry Forms and payment of entry fees and cost of meals is 16 February 2024.
 - a. At the sole discretion of the Rally Director, late submitted Entry Forms and payment of entry fees and cost of meals may be accepted during the period from 17 February to 15 March 2024.
 - b. No entries will be accepted on or after 16 March 2024.
3. Instructions for lodgement of Entry Forms, payment of entry fees and cost of meals are provided on the last page of this document.
4. Registration for the Bushman's Rally will be at the Club rooms of the Broken Hill Veteran and Vintage Car Club, 246 Blende Street (next to Fire Station) from 1:00pm – 6.00pm, Friday 29 March 2024.
Afternoon tea will be supplied, plus bar will be open for purchase of drinks.
5. Updated information will be provided in the Rally Packs to be distributed at the Registration point.
Those Rally Packs not collected on Friday will be available on Saturday.
6. Starting point on Saturday morning will be at the Centro Plaza car park next to McDonalds, Garnet Street. Please arrive by 9.00am for departure at 9.30am.
7. The run on Saturday morning will include a visit to the Perilya Mine Museum and a tour of the mine workings. Locations for morning tea and lunch to be added.
A round trip for the day of approximately 20kms.
8. Saturday's evening meal and trivia night will be held at the Musicians Club, 276 Crystal Street, commencing at 6:30pm. The cost for this meal includes a soup entrée and alternate drop of chicken Schnitzel with mash potato, vegetables and gravy or Roast Lamb with roast potato & pumpkin, mixed greens & carrots.
9. Sunday morning will again start at Centro Plaza car park next to McDonalds, Garnet Street. Cars to arrive from 9am for departure at 9.30am.
10. The run on Sunday will include a visit to the Sulphide Street Railway & Historical Museum, 230 Blende Street where morning tea will be served. Then it will be off to Twin Lakes, Silver City Highway (Wentworth Road) for the Show & Shine where lunch will be served.
11. The Presentation Dinner on Sunday evening will be held at the Musicians Club, 276 Crystal Street, commencing at 6.30pm. The cost for this meal includes an alternate drop. Entrée, Pumpkin Arancini or Chicken Satay Spring Rolls. Main, Beef Cheeks with mash potato, vegetables & mushroom spring onion sauce or Fresh Water Barramundi with Asian salad & lemon caper sauce. Dessert, Chocolate panna cotta or lemon cheese cake.
